SUMMARY: The Histopathology program is in need of a work study student who will assist Dr. Demarest and Dr. Neary in the Histopathology lab and courses. The student will learn and perform basic lab maintenance duties – inventory, ordering, sample and solution preparation, organization, and cleaning. Students may also function as a teaching assistant (TA) in some of the Histopathology courses, particularly Histology I, Histology II, and Basic Laboratory Techniques.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

1. Routine cleaning and organization of lab spaces
2. Maintain inventory of lab supplies and recommend items for ordering
3. Perform routine testing of lab reagents
4. Test new assays as directed
5. TA in Histopathology courses

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Be a current **Rowan–Virtua Health College of Medicine & Life Sciences** student in good overall academic and financial standing. Experience with histology is a plus.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

Frequent standing, walking, sitting, grasping, carrying and speaking. Occasional reaching, bending and stooping. Lifting, carrying, pushing and pulling up to 50 pounds, with assistance if needed. Occasional use of computer, keyboard, copy and fax machine and phone.
