Transfer Credit Policy

Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences (GSBS)

A syllabus for the course must be provided for review.

Credits for graduate courses taken at other colleges or universities may be transferred upon approval by the Program Director(s) and the relevant course director. Any course(s) approved for transfer will exempt the student from taking that required course(s) in the program.

No transfer credits are allowed for courses in which the applicant received less than a B (3.0).

The number of credits awarded shall not exceed the number of credits given for an equivalent course at GSBS.

There is no charge for transfer credits.

Masters of Biomedical Sciences Program (MBS)

A maximum of 6 credits may be transferred toward the MBS degree.

Cell and Molecular Biology Program (CMB)

A maximum of 12 credits may be transferred towards the PhD degree if the classes were taken prior to matriculation.

A maximum of 6 credits may be transferred towards the MS degree if they were taken prior to matriculation.

Master of Science in Histopathology Program (MHP)

A maximum of 10 credits may be transferred toward the MHP degree. Determination of course and credit equivalency may require demonstration of technical proficiency.

Master of Science in Molecular Pathology and Immunology Program (MPI)

No credits may be transferred toward the MSMPI program.
